Re: Fredericton Airport - PSAC Members on Strike

Twenty five PSAC members went on strike against the Fredericton Airport Authority on Monday, February 13, 2012.

This will be a particularly difficult strike for the PSAC and the members involved because fully 15 workers have been declared essential and are required to work clearing runways and the like in the event of snow storms. This coupled by the fact that 6 management representatives have been assigned by the Airport Authority to do bargaining unit work means that our ability to win this strike is dependent on people refusing to cross our picket line and essentially boycott the airport.

The labour movement and individual union members are in a position to help our members at the airport by refusing to use the airport and telling the employer that they will not fly from Fredericton until an agreement is reached.
